## COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

### REQUIRED COURSES

**English 7** is the study of grammar and usage, vocabulary and spelling, and clear, effective writing.

**Pre-AP English 7** provides a greater depth of content, a wider scope of material, extended research techniques and additional works of literature, distinguishing it from the English 7 course.

**Reading** is a course designed to improve reading skills in comprehension and vocabulary through a literary approach.

**Mathematics 7** follows the Connected Mathematics Project curriculum which uses an investigative approach to learning algebraic, probability, and geometric concepts.

**Science 7** is an integrated, hands-on approach to learning life, earth, and physical science concepts.

**Social Studies 7** provides a study of the world through four strands: geography, civics, history, and economics.

**Arkansas History** provides a study of the history of Arkansas. The course addresses the geographic features and economics of our state, focusing on political, social religious, military, scientific, and cultural developments that have occurred over time.

**Physical Education and Health - Regular** is designed to develop motor skills, improve coordination and provide students with an understanding of personal health wellness.

**Physical Education and Health - Sports** is designed for students who plan to take part in competitive athletics and to provide students with an understanding of personal health wellness.

**Developmental Reading** is provided for students requiring additional instruction to master basic reading skills.

### ELECTIVE COURSES

**Band** is the study of instrumental music and includes many types of compositions from classical to modern. Students learn to play an instrument and gain an appreciation of many forms of music.

**Choral Music** is the study of vocal music. Students learn to sing as a choir and to develop an appreciation of music.

### **ROTATION:**

**Art** introduces students to the principles of design and color as applied to various art activities. *One-semester course.*

**Skills Enhancement Literacy** is an individualized course designed to increase student achievement in literacy. *Nine-weeks course.*

**Skills Enhancement Mathematics** is an individualized course designed to increase student achievement in mathematics. *Nine-weeks course.*
